THE OBVIOUS PROBLEM OF DEATH - 7:11-12

It is Inevitable and Cannot Be Humanly Changed: *...there was a dead man carried out,*

Death Comes upon All Men, Women and Children, Regardless of Their Life and Importance - *Luke 8:49*

THE NEED FOR LIFE AND COMPASSION OF CHRIST - 7:13

The Lord Knows About Death - *Luke 8:50; John 11:14*

The Lord Acts With Compassion and Understanding - *he had compassion on her, and said unto her, Weep not. - John 11:33-35*

THE PROVISION OF LIFE FROM CHRIST - 7:14-15

Jesus Acted with Great Power and Authority - *And he came and touched the bier: and they that bare him stood still. And he said, Young man, I say unto thee, Arise. Luke 8:54; John 11:23, 11:39, 43*

The dead received life immediately and began to speak - *And he that was dead sat up, and began to speak and he delivered him to his mother. Luke 8:55; John 11:44*

THE RESULTS OF GIVING LIFE - 7:16-18

*And there came a fear on all: *Cf. Luke 8:56*

*and they glorified God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That God hath visited his people.

*And this rumour of him went forth throughout all Judaea, and throughout all the region round about. *John 11:45*

*And the disciples of John shewed him of all these things.
