ZACCHAEUS WAS IMPORTANT - 19:1,5 *And Jesus entered and passed through Jericho.*

*\*CF. 19:5 ... Jesus came to the place, he looked up, and saw him, and said unto him, Zacchaeus, make haste, and come down; for to day I must abide at thy house.*

ZACCHAEUS WAS INFLUENTIAL - 19:2 *And, behold, there was a man named Zacchaeus, which was the chief among the publicans, and he was rich.*

ZACCHAEUS WAS INVESTIGATIVE - 19:3 *And he sought to see Jesus who he was;*

ZACCHAEUS WAS IMPEDED - 19:3 *...and could not for the press, because he was little of stature.*

ZACCHAEUS WAS IMAGINATIVE - 19:4 *And he ran before, and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see him...*

ZACCHAEUS WAS INSPIRED - 19:5 *And when Jesus came to the place...6 And he made haste, and came down, and received him joyfully.*

ZACCHAEUS WAS INVOLVED - 19:8 *And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore him fourfold.*

ZACCHAEUS WAS INVITED - 19:9-10 *And Jesus said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house, forsomuch as he also is a son of Abraham. For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.*
